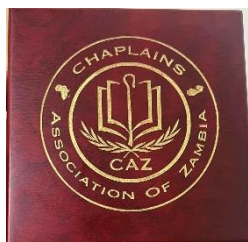

As a result of the vision of our World Missions Director Dr Thomas Propes a Medical Clinic was erected outside the city limits of Lusaka, Zambia which will be dedicated in April/May next year. In addition to that a well was drilled and dedicated in Niger and Mali. Both are countries in the Sahel Zone where the need for water in some areas is hard to image. More wells are to follow in

January in Togo and another one in Niger. Through these access ministries people are being reached with the Gospel while being tangibly ministered to in their need.
