The **Doctor of Ministry** program offered in Africa by the *Pentecostal Theological Seminary, is* now in its second year and is going strong.

Rhino refugee camp in Uganda: This is one of the world's largest refugee camps! People from neighboring South Sudan fled here to escape the civil war. John Noah Komi (national overseer) and his wife Edna planted 59 churches in the camps. He and national education director Nicolas Lolik Lemi trained pastors and leaders. April 17-20, Charles Karangwa (Superintendent East Africa) and I traveled to their national convention. The graduation was a joyful part of their national gathering.

August 11, we received the sad news that John Noah Komi was promoted to glory.

Third Master program cohort students: This cohort met for two-week modules in January and September respectively. In January, Dr. Peter Thomas and Kim Franks taught a leadership and hermeneutics class, while in September Dr. Greg Sloop and Dr. Steve Mills taught New Testament and Church History. This program convenes at the beautiful Leopards Hill Conference Center in Zambia.

French-speaking West Africa: 'ToT' stands for Teaching of Teachers, and is a Diploma program offered in partner-

ship with the *European Theological Seminary*. This year's first module met June 6-16, and the upcoming module will convene November 7-17 in the newly opened Send-the-Light ministry center in Lomé. Timothy Gbo (Superintendent for Francophone West Africa) is an awesome host. Three national overseers from his region are part of the student body.

Portuguese-speaking Bible School in Angola: Joseph Ndashe (Superintendent Central Africa) and

Prayer & Harvest Summit 2023: August 20-25, the Church of God Africa convened for the *Harvest & Prayer Strategic Planning Summit* in Lusaka, Zambia. Leaders from 40 nations gathered for a time of prayer, consultation and planning.
